

Improve the NoRo services for patients with RD – **Centre of expertise !!!**

**Ob. 1 National Committee for Rare Diseases** → became the National Council for Rare Diseases at Ministry of Health: [www.ms.ro](http://www.ms.ro)



**National Plan for Rare Diseases** → included in the National Strategy for Health 2014-2020; 13 CoE accredited – 10 HCP participate in 6 ERNs;

### Ob.2 NoRo center :

- Day care center is funded by the Local Council and County Council + NHI (BBBS, Mol, OMV Petrom)
- Patient groups & development– partly funded by the project *ExpertRARE* – Center of Expertise for RD, funded by Swiss Romanian Cooperation Program
  - *Medical department establishment and accreditation – project and County Health Insurance*
  - *ISO – Management Standards*
  - *Patient pathways are improved through case management implementation*
  - *Patient Registry for NoRo*
- HelpLine part of the Eurordis network of Helplines
- [www.edubolirare.ro](http://www.edubolirare.ro) : training courses for Personal assistants (DASC) and training for Rehabilitation teacher (County Council Alba through a POSDRU project), case management, nutrition in PKU, PWS, etc.

## 1. Resource centre: complex services + innovation

### Who and how?

2. Weak coordination between health care, psychosocial complementary care, between central and regional/local infrastructures, between sectors and between Ministries, leading to a lack of multidisciplinary holistic approach

## 2. Centralized approach

- Maximise patients' access to services – describing patient pathways
- Understanding the way patients move within and between different medical and social care providers
- Communication with other CoE and other services
- Training for different professionals
- Communication with other services at local, regional, national and international level

### 3. Patient focus

- Ensure representation of different providers


Lack of long term, funded and sustainable policies and structures at national levels and in the national strategies for the integration of people living with RD into social services and policies
